What are Pacific West Gymnastics' Edu-Boost Learning Camps?

Edu-Boost Learning Camps provide a safe space for your child to work on their virtual learning while engaging in physical fitness and social enrichment with the support and guidance of our staff.

What grades will be able to attend?

Our camps are offered for grades Kindergarten through 5th.

What schools and districts are eligible?

Edu-Boost Learning Camps are open to all districts and schools.

Where will Edu-Boost Learning Camps be held?

Pacific West Gymnastics will be offering camps at both Fremont and Union City locations. Camps will be held in our large, spacious facilities.

What are the hours?

Monday through Friday, 7:45am to 2:45pm. Edu-Boost Learning Camps are closed on major holidays and follow school closure calendars.

Is this program associated with a local school district (Fremont Unified, New Haven, Newark Unified, etc.)

No. Pacific West Gymnastics' Edu-Boost Learning Camps are designed so parents can drop their children off and receive supervision and assistance with their school provided distance learning curriculum.

What type of enrichment opportunities will be offered?

In addition to assisting children with schoolwork, our staff will lead physical education activities such as gymnastics or dance lessons, science experiments and art lessons.

Who are the staff and what are their qualifications?

All of our staff are CPR, First Aid and AED trained and certified, and hold Concussion Safety certification from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Additionally, staff are USA Gymnastics Instructor certified, have completed U.S. Center for SafeSport training, and have received background check clearance from the National Center for Safety Initiatives and Department of Justice/LiveScan. Our staff have worked with children for many years and have previous experience coaching classes, camps, birthday parties and special events.

What does my child need to bring daily?

- Facemask
- Laptop or tablet and charger
- Headphones
- Textbooks
- Worksheets/school assignments
- Backpack
- Snacks, lunch and water bottle

Is my child required to wear a facemask? What about staff?

Facemasks are required for all - children and staff members.
